HUD Section 811 built in 1992 with a Capital Advance. No pay back as long as housing purpose remains for 40 years.

24 apartments for persons with physical disabilities who pay rents of 30% of adjusted income. HUD pays remaining costs through budgetary process.

HUD Section 811 built in 1996 with a Capital Advance. No pay back as long as housing purpose remains for 40 years.
